

CONFIGURING HP THIN CLIENTS

Download the following files from the HP Website

1. SP45662.EXE – Adobe Acrobat Reader 9.1 (add-on suitable for thin clients)
2. SP45253.EXE - HP Printer Connection utility

Please configure your HP Thin Clients as mentioned below:

Login as Administration (Shift->Start->Log Off)
(User Name : Administrator / Password =Administrator)

1. Go to Control Panel and increase the RAM DISK capacity upto 64 MB using HP RAMDISK Manager.
2. Go to HP EWF Configuration Tool available in the Control panel and press the Commit Data. Further press Done to Write in the memory.
3. Restart the Thin Client

4. Login to Administrator
5. Create two directories namely TEMP and TMP at the C:Drive.
6. Go to My Computer. Press Right Click and go Properties. Select Advanced and select Environment Variables.
7. Go to User Variables, System Variables and set the TEMP and TMP directories from Z Drive to C Drive as mentioned below by selecting EDIT Button.

8. TEMP=C:\TEMP
9. TMP=C:\TMP

10. Press "OK".
11. Also Set the Virtual Memory by Selecting the Advance Option. (Paging Size Initial Size 512 and Maximum is 1024). Apply the Changes.
12. Go to HP EWF Configuration and press Commit Data and Press Done Button.
13. Restart your Computer.
14. Login thru Administrator and by using the Pen Drive install the Adobe Acrobat Reader 9.1 (Add-on) Downloaded file website and Printer Utility directly from the Pen Drive one by one.

15. Restart the Thin Clients and start using the Acrobat and the Printer Connection Utility.

Note : HP Thin Clients supports compatible printer drivers available in add printer wizard. Use appropriate compatible drivers for your printers and share it for smooth function. In case of any configuration change go to Control Panel, EWF Configuration Tool, Commit the Changes and Press Done Button to save the changes effects in the thin Clients. Restart it before use. Disable or remove the Symantech Anti Virus programme for better performance.
